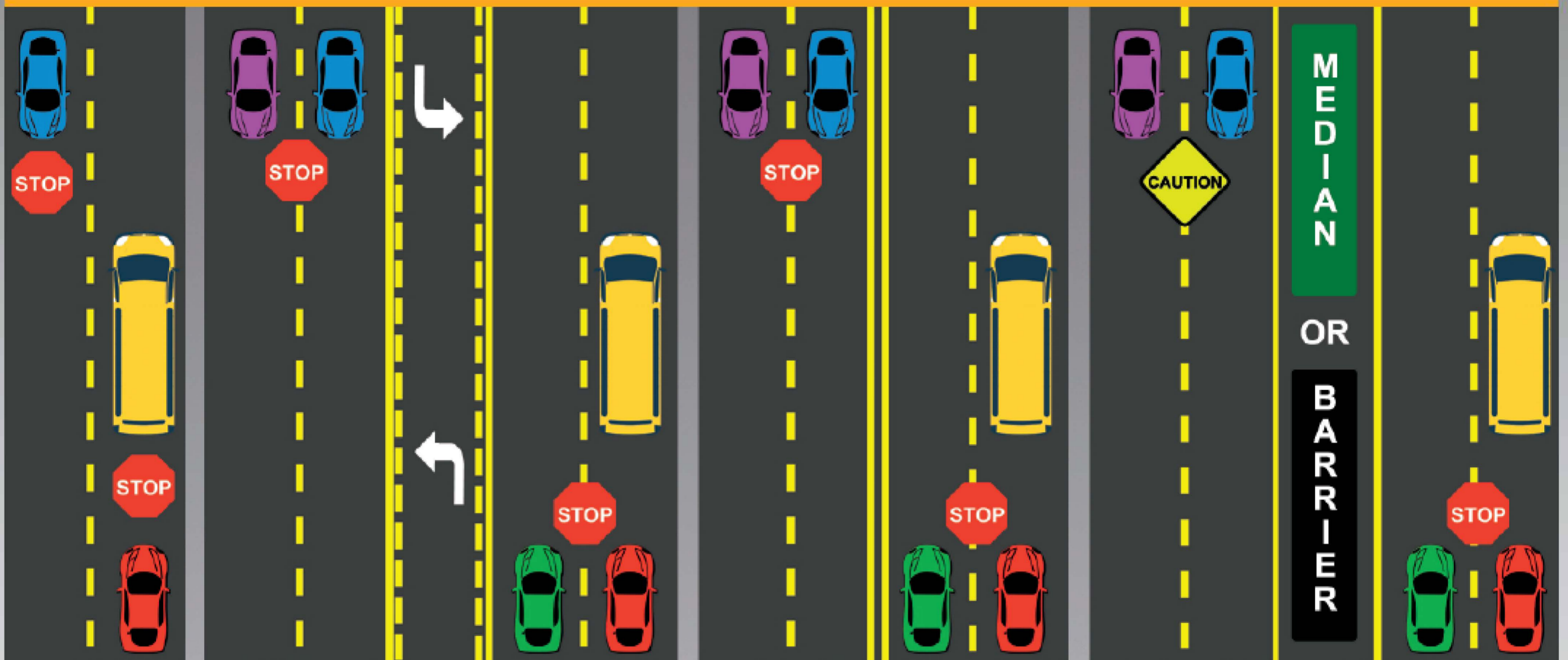

What is the law in Maryland?



TWO-LANE:
Vehicles traveling
in both directions
MUST STOP.

TWO-LANE with center turn lane:
Vehicles traveling in both directions
MUST STOP.

MULTI-LANE:
Vehicles traveling in both directions
MUST STOP.

DIVIDED HIGHWAY:
With dirt, grass, or barrier median- Vehicles
behind the bus **MUST STOP.**
Vehicles traveling in opposite direction use
CAUTION.

Drivers who don't stop **LOSE!**

- Pay fines
- Points on license
- Put children's lives at risk

A driver who fails to stop at least 20 feet from the rear or front of the bus is violating the law.

You can help keep children SAFE

Did you see someone pass a stopped school bus? Use this card to help you report the incident to your local law enforcement agency.

The Police will need the following information:

- **Description of the vehicle**
 - Color
 - Make & model
 - Body type (i.e., sedan, two-door, convertible, SUV, etc.)
 - Unique elements (i.e., damaged, window/bumper stickers, etc.)
- **License plate**
 - Number
 - State
- **Description of the driver**
